We wish to invite you and your staff to attend the upcoming rural Level 1 FoodSafe course.

**Monday November 4, 2019**

**8:30am - 4:30pm**

**Wolseley Memorial Integrated Care Centre (Lakeside Nursing home) in the Activity Room**

Food Safe Level 1 is a food-handling, sanitation and work safety course designed for frontline foodservice workers such as cooks, servers, bus-persons, dishwashers and care home employees. The course covers important food safety and worker safety information on foodborne illness, receiving and storing food, preparing food, serving food, cleaning and sanitizing.

Under the Food Safety Regulations, at least one employee preparing food in a food service establishment must hold a Food Safe Level 1 certificate, or a certificate from a course recognized as equivalent to Food Safe Level 1.

Participants who score 70% or higher on the final exam will receive a Level 1 Safe Food Handler certificate from the Saskatchewan Health Authority. The certificate does not expire, though it is recommended that participants retake the course after 5 years.

Course & manual fee is \$65 (no tax)
