

BYLAW NO. 3-05

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WOLSELEY IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 1-89 KNOWN AS THE CAT BYLAW.

The Council of the Town of Wolseley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Section 8. (f) be amended to state:

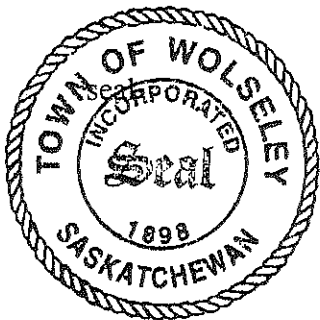
“The owner, possessor or harbored of any cat impounded as asforesaid shall pay the Town, in advance of release of the said cat, the sum of \$50.00 for impounding of the said cat, and the sum of \$50.00 for any subsequent impounding of the same cat, plus the sum of \$50.00 per day or part thereof for each day that the cat shall have remained in the said pound.


That Section 10 (a) be amended to state:


“ Any person convicted of an offense under Section 3 and /or Section 5 of this Bylaw shall forfeit and pay a fine of \$50.00 dollars, exclusive of costs”

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.


