

BYLAW NO. 5-05

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WOLSELEY IN THE  
PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO  
AMEND BYLAW 1-89 KNOWN AS THE  
CAT BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Wolseley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That section 3(c) which states "No person or persons residing in the same dwelling unit may license more than two (2) cats" be removed from the bylaw.
2. That section 3 (b) which states " All licenses will be issued without a fee and are valid for the life of each cat" be amended to state" Every person within the municipality who owns, possesses or harbors a cat shall obtain a license from the Town Administrator. The license shall be in effect from January 1st to December 31st of a calendar year, and shall be obtained on or before January 31st of the current year."


This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final reading.


READ A FIRST TIME this 6th day of April, 2005
