With the assistance of HMC Management Inc. (HMC), Mayor Gerry Hill and the Council of the Town of Wolseley are excited to announce the appointment of Ms. Julia Schofer to the newly created position of Community Development Coordinator (CDC) effective June 24, 2024.

Council undertook an in-depth and structured recruitment process under the guidance of HMC that generated several qualified candidates.

The Community Development Coordinator position is a new and full-time position for the Town. Under the general direction of Council and reporting to the Chief Administrative Officer, Ms. Schofer is directly responsible for the development and growth of the community, focusing primarily on the emergency management response, historical, cultural, economic, and business development, residential growth, tourism, parks, and recreation functions.

The position is also expected to engage with and support volunteer boards, local businesses, community projects and Council with their commitment to innovation and community engagement.

Ms. Schofer is very well suited for this new role having gained related experience with the City of Yorkton Recreation and Community Services Department as a Recreation Coordinator. Also, Ms. Schofer has volunteered and worked with the Saskatchewan Parks and Recreation Association, Parkland Valley Sport, Culture & Recreation District and Skate Canada.

Ms. Schoffer has earned a Bachelor's Degree in Sport and Recreation Management, a Diploma in Business Administration from the University of Regina as well as a Diploma in Recreation and Community Development from Saskatchewan Polytechnic.
