BYLAW NO. 02-2016

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WOLSELEY IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 6-2006 KNOWN AS THE ASSESSMENT APPEAL FEE BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Wolseley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. That Section 4 which states, "A fee of \$50.00 per appeal is hereby established for the purpose of filing an appeal to the Board." be amended to state, "A fee of \$100.00 per appeal is hereby established for the purpose of filing an appeal to the Board."
- 2. That Section 8 which states, "A fee of \$10.00 per appeal is hereby established for any person who desires to be involved as a party in a hearing before the Board." be amended to state, "A fee of \$20.00 per appeal is hereby established for any person who desires to be involved as a party in a hearing before the Board."
- 3. That Section 9 which states, "A fee of \$10.00 per appeal is hereby established for any person who wishes to obtain copies of the Board's decision and other documents." be amended to state, "A fee of \$20.00 per appeal is hereby established for any person who wishes to obtain copies of the Board's decision and other documents."

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final reading.
