Notice to Residents of Wolseley:

The Town has become aware of a possible scam targeting residents of Wolseley.

Some residents have reported being contacted by individuals claiming to represent internet service providers and offering upgrades to higher internet speeds. These callers have been requesting personal information from residents; however, they are not legitimate representatives of these companies.

We would like to remind residents that SaskTel will be the only company contacting customers regarding upgrades to InfinET services. SaskTel representatives will never ask for your credit card information. If SaskTel already has your account information on file, they may only ask for the last three digits of your account number to verify your identity.

Residents are encouraged to exercise caution when receiving unsolicited phone calls and should never provide personal, financial, or account information unless they are certain they are speaking with a legitimate representative.
