BYLAW NO. 08-2016

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 02-2015 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Wolseley, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 02-2015 as follows:

1. Section 2 Definitions is amended by adding the word “Storage” and shall have the following definition unless the context indicates otherwise:

Storage: *The methods of storing goods outdoors for future use in connection with the land. Exclusions include, but are not limited to:*

- *Storage in the required front yard of any residential site;*
- *Storage of hazardous/chemical materials;*
- *Storage of wrecked, partially dismantled or inoperable vehicle or machinery which may leak anti-freeze, oil, and other chemicals;*
- *Storage deemed undesirable in a residential district; etc.*

2. Section 7 Residential District (R1), subsection (7.2) Discretionary Uses, is amended by adding immediately after sub-subsection (7.2)(g), the following new sub-subsection:

“ h) Storage (*refer to section 7.8 of Bylaw 02-2015*) ”.

3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when adopted by Council.

READ A SECOND TIME this 21ST day of DECEMBER, 2016

READ A THIRD TIME AND ADOPTED this 21ST day of DECEMBER, 2016
